

Teacher

Responsible for the planning and implementation of daily classroom curriculum activities for a group of up to 20 children, up to 4 years of age – Upper Shore Head Start Centers and Lower Shore Centers.

- Assists in the delivery of health, education and social services to Head Start Program children and their families. This includes those with intellectual and/or physical disabilities.
- Participate in active supervision of children arriving and departing on buses as assigned and/or needed.

CDA Trainee (Starting at \$14.37 hourly)

A high school diploma or GED is required. The applicant must be working on a Child Development Associate (CDA) credential while obtaining experience working with infants and toddlers, or have immediate plans to obtain the credential.

Teacher I (Starting at \$15.28 hourly)

Teacher I must have a high school diploma or GED and a current Child Development Associate (CDA) credential.

Teacher II (Starting at \$16 hourly)

Teacher II must have an associate's degree in Early Childhood Education or a related field, including Child Development, Special Education, Human Development/Ecology, Child & Studies, Psychology – Birth to 8 or Social Work. Experience working with infants and toddlers is preferred. Highly qualified applicants are considered.

Teacher III (Starting at \$17.19 hourly)

Teacher III must have a bachelor's degree in Early Childhood Education or a related field, including Child Development, Special Education, Human Development/Ecology, Child & Studies, Psychology – Birth to 8 or Social Work. Experience working with infants and toddlers is preferred. Highly qualified applicants are considered.
